#### Welcome to *i*GPIO!

Thanks for using our products and services ("Services"). The Services are provided by CyberLogic, Inc. ("CyberLogic, Inc."), located at 611 Broadway, Suite 707, New York, NY 10012, United States.

#### Information we collect

We collect very little information from you, but for example we do use Google Ads on our website so Google will use its information about you to present specific ads to you. We collect information in two ways:

• **Information you give us.** For example, many of our services require you to sign up for an *i*GPIO Account. When you do, we'll ask for personal information, like your name, email address, and also ask you to choose a password. If you want to use one of our premium ("VIP") accounts, we will also ask you for credit card info.

• **Information we get from your use of our services.** We collect information about the Services that you use and how you use them, like how many devices you are using and how many channels you use on each device. We may also collect information on how often you update the *i*GPIO website, and how many system emails you send per day. We do this in order to ensure the reliability of the Services.

## How we use information we collect

We use the information we collect from our Services to provide, maintain, protect and improve them, to develop new ones, and to protect *i*GPIO and our users. When you contact *i*GPIO, we keep a record of your communication to help solve any issues you might be facing. We may use your email address to inform you about our Services, such as letting you know about upcoming changes or improvements.

We will ask for your consent before using information for a purpose other than those that are set out in this Privacy Policy.

#### Information we share

We do not share any of your personal information with any companies, organizations and individuals outside of *i*GPIO unless one of the following circumstances applies:

## • With your consent

We will share personal information with companies, organizations or individuals outside of *i*GPIO when we have your consent to do so. We require opt-in consent for the sharing of any sensitive personal information.

## • With domain administrators

If your *i*GPIO Account is managed for you by someone other than yourself ("domain administrator(s)"), then that/those person or persons and/or resellers who provide user support to your organization will have access to your *i*GPIO Account information (including your email and other data). Your domain administrator may be able to:

- view statistics regarding your account, like statistics regarding applications you install.
- change your account password.
- suspend or terminate your account access.
- access or retain information stored as part of your account.
- receive your account information in order to satisfy applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request.
- restrict your ability to delete or edit information or privacy settings.

# • For external processing

We provide personal information to our Merchant Services (i.e., PayPal) to process credit card payments for us, based on our instructions and in compliance with our Privacy Policy and any other appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

#### • For legal reasons

We will share personal information with companies, organizations or individuals outside of *i*GPIO if we have a good-faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of the information is reasonably necessary to:

- meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request.
- enforce applicable Terms of Service, including investigation of potential violations.
- detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues.
- protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of *i*GPIO, our users or the public as required or permitted by law.

We may share aggregated, non-personally identifiable information publicly and with our partners – like advertisers or connected sites. For example, we may share information publicly to show trends about the general use of our services.

If *i*GPIO is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, we will continue to ensure the confidentiality of any personal information and give affected users notice before personal information is transferred or becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

## Information security

We work hard to protect *i*GPIO and our users from unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of information we hold. In particular:

- We encrypt our service using SSL and your password is encrypted as well
- We review our information collection, storage and processing practices, including physical security measures, to guard against unauthorized access to systems.
- We restrict access to personal information to *i*GPIO employees, contractors and agents who need to know that information in order to process it for us, and who are subject to strict contractual confidentiality obligations and may be disciplined or terminated if they fail to meet these obligations.
